MAKING A BIRDBATH


Materials Needed:

2 terracotta flower pots (1 large and 1 medium)

1 saucer (plastic or terracotta)

Method:

1. Turn the large flowerpot upside down, then place the medium flowerpot upside down on top of that. The weight of the terracotta pots will give the stack better stability.



- 2. Centre the saucer on top of the stack and put a rock in it. This will help to keep the saucer on the stack in windy weather. You could use strong glue to stick the saucer to the top pot, but just using a rock lets you remove the saucer more easily for cleaning.
- 3. Place the birdbath in a suitable spot, such as the edge of a border. Add smaller stones so birds can perch to drink the fresh, clear water. The stones will also enable thirsty bees to drink from the bath, without danger of drowning.
